



A Level Options 2019/2020

All students entering Year 12 in September will be starting a programme of study at Advanced Subsidiary level (AS). This qualification serves as a stepping stone to Advanced level (A2) courses which will be taken in year 13. Since the (AS) level is meant to be between GCSE and Advanced level in its standard it is expected that many students will study FOUR (AS) subjects in Year 12 and then continue with THREE subjects at (A2) level in Year 13. However, there may be some students who would prefer to just start with three (AS) level subjects in Year 12 and to continue with these in Year 13.

In arranging the timetable, our aim is to provide an Option system for Year 12 study that will cater for the (AS) level choices of as many pupils as possible. It is impossible to guarantee to offer every possible combination of subjects, but we do hope that the Option system below will meet the requirements of the vast majority. If you feel that there is a combination of subjects that you would like to do but can not be done under this Option system, then please indicate this on the form below. It may be possible once all forms are returned to make some small changes to make this possible.

At this stage it is appreciated that your proposed choices are only provisional and may well change after the GCSE results are known in August. However, it is important to realise that any future changes will only be possible if they are able to work on the published school timetable. A list of the possible subject combinations will be made available after all of the Option returns have been analysed. **The Options Choices form below should be returned to me no later than Friday 15th March 2019.**
